Apply for Funding

Northwest Developers, Inc. appreciates your interest in submitting a funding request. Before you submit your application, please determine whether your request fits the Northwest Developers mission, and review a list of organizations the foundation has previously funded. Please contact us if you are unsure whether your program is a good fit.

What should a donation request contain?

Your request should include the following materials, and be approximately five pages in length:

1. A completed Donation Request Form
 - Download in Microsoft Word Format
2. A Proposal breaking out the following details:
 - Your organization's history, mission and contact information
 - A description of the program you wish to fund – please include how many people/students you serve annually, and on an ongoing basis.
 - The amount of funding you wish to provide, and how the funds are to be used.
3. Your total program/project budget
4. Your total annual organizational budget – break down all salary/payroll amounts in your organization.
5. A copy of your proof of 501(c)(3) status

All requests must align with Northwest Developers mission: “Helping to enhance the health and welfare of low to moderate income families in the Newark and surrounding areas of Essex County, New Jersey.”

When will donations be made?

The Northwest Developers makes donations at various times throughout the year. The Northwest Developers will notify your organization by email within the week of receipt of your request and then again after the Board of Directors makes its funding decisions.

What is the average donation amount given by Northwest Developers?

Northwest Developers reviews donation requests with a wide variety of funding needs. Most requests range from \$200 to \$10,000. Organizations are reminded to base their requested amount on the program's unique needs for funding.

When and where should a donation request be submitted?

Are there any restrictions?

In general, the Northwest Developers does not fund:

- Donations to candidates for political office
- Donations for building or construction projects
- Donations for debt reduction or capital campaigns
- Donations for graduate or postgraduate research

We fund only organizations in the United States

If awarded, is there any follow-up required?

Northwest Developers requires organizations that have received funding to submit a follow-up report to them no later than three – six months after receipt of funding.

Reports should include overall project outcomes and results as well as any supplemental materials, e.g., event photographs, printed materials, newsletters, etc.
